## All submittals will be reviewed in accordance with the following review and ranking criteria:

- 2. Is the submitter's related experience appropriate? Up to 25 Points
- 3. Are the submitter's key staff qualified to perform work on behalf of CVR, HUD, and other CVR clients? **Up to 25 Points**



- 4. Are the proposed rates reasonable? CVR reserves the right to enter into negotiations. **Up to 25 Points**
- 5. Is the submitter listed as a party that is excluded from federal procurements? If yes, submittal must be rejected.

## The minimum score required for selection shall be 70 points.

Respondents who meet this threshold may be asked to participate in an interview prior to being added to a specific project or engagement. The interview process will allow CVR to further assess qualifications, experience, and overall alignment with specific project needs before entering into a project work order.
